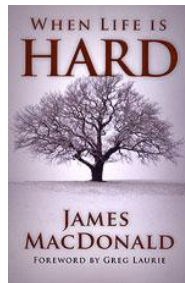


Throughout the summer, our Kingdom Kids and Korner will join together for "Secret Agent Mission". Your kids ages 5-12 are invited to join in!
